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Direct Beneficiary:	Target group: The 6 month, anti-bullying project 'Stop Bullying in Kosovo', primarily will benefit 60 boys and girls, age group (11-16), from different ethnic groups and their families in three municipalities (Prishtinë/a; Fushë Kosovë / Kosovo Polje, Obiliq/c). Final beneficiaries: The campaigning skills training will be implemented with the young people (11- 16) which will result in massive educational campaign whose goal will be to raise awareness amongst the larger public to explore bullying and other forms of violence as a failure of democracy.

Target Area:	Prishtinë/a; Fushë Kosovë / Kosovo Polje, Obiliq/c
Overall Objective:	The project main goal is to mobilize Kosovo Youth in securing for themselves and the others full human rights in Kosovo society through education, dialogue and advocacy against all forms of bullying in schools, families and in the community.
Activities:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Setting school based task forces (TF) /advocates for safer schools. 2. Weekly meetings after school for about 1 hour, round table style. 3. Designing short and simple surveys (based in good practices from our previous projects and elsewhere around the world) in monitoring their school climate. 3. These surveys will be implemented by the YP and will provide us with in-depth information on bullying and how it affects children, young people, parent, carers and teachers. 4. Media training in creating safe FB pages to publish the TF/ advocacy work. 5. Anti - bullying training workshops for the TF/ Advocates. 6. Parenting training in violence prevention through positive discipline techniques in support to Anti Bullying campaign in the targeted schools. 7. Anti-bullying awareness events and presentations to educate school staff, parents and community leaders, quarterly. 8. Training in Oral history 9. Landscaping or performing (dance or drama) the oral history stories on bullying; 10. Producing anti-bullying campaign film 11. Anti - Bullying Kosovo Campaign website originally created in 2015: will become the safe platform to combat bullying and centralise the surveys, the educational material gathered by the advocates during the project. 12. Results:	<p>Within 6 months the project aims to achieve the following objectives...</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. School based youth task- forces(TF) are formed and the quarterly reports in 6 targeted schools in 6 targeted municipalities (Prishtine/a, Obiliq/c, Fushe Kosove/o), show bullying incidents in schools and in the communities are decreasing. 2. The forums for dialogues and exchanges are set up between school stakeholders (teachers,



administrators, parents and students) in identifying and enforcing bullying prevention techniques, particularly within the school settings and developing capacity amongst the school community, notably the 60 youth leaders developing advocacy skills.

3. All targeted children(60) and their schools communities have better understanding of different kinds of bullying, they can identify strategies, people and organisations that can support children being bullied, by the end of the project these children will be able to analyse and act on different responses to bullying
