Summary of the intervention:	<p>EC will still remain a community-based organization. Topics and issues may vary, but what remains constant is the methodology. EC believes in the need and necessity of community organization as the greatest guarantee of democratization and development. Democracy and development lie in dependency, while the latter must necessarily be implemented in frameworks of sustainability. The conceptual triangle that will guide the work of the organization in the period 2020 - 2024 has the following elements: 1. Inclusiveness, 2. Sustainability, and 3. Knowledge.</p> <p>The activity of the organization will aim at meeting three strategic objectives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Well-organized local communities and increased public pressure promote advanced practices of democratic and inclusive governance in Kosovo municipalities.</li> <li>ii. Environmental and social dimensions integrated into programs and policies aimed at balanced and sustainable local and regional development.</li> <li>iii. Increased volume of sectoral knowledge to nurture social debate and policy-making, as well as an organization with consolidated programmatic skills and institutional sustainability.</li> </ul>
